Transfer of ILPS Registration as non-profit organization to Germany

On February 1, 2013 the representatives of ILPS memberships received the Board request to participate as founding member with signing the application form for registration of the ILPS Society in Germany. With these supporting letters ILPS Secretary Bernd Diehl will initiate the registration. After settlement of this registration, the USA registration will be ceased.

We will continue to organize 1 or 2 annual meetings of the European Analytical Subgroup in Europe and will combine one of these meetings with the new Annual General Meeting. ILPS will continue the close connection with the AOCS Phospholipid Division and one meeting will be held parallel to the AOCS annual meeting in N-America. ILPS will enlarge its focus and pulling the basic structures of networking between the members from industry and universities. We aim to increasing the number of active members.

As a consequence we have already terminated the website maintenance contract with Little Shoes Media Inc, USA. ILPS thanks webmaster Bernie Szuhaj Jr. for his many years of service. Currently the website www.ilps.org is not on line, but we work on the re-open the website soon. You will be informed.

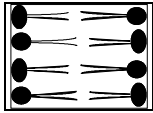
Short Course: Lecithin Functions in Technology and Nutrition

The short course will feature world class experts presenting on technological functions of vegetable lecithin; preparation and characterization of emulsions and liposomal dispersions;

- General Phospholipids

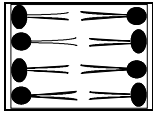
AOCS BEST PHOSPHOLIPID PAPER AWARD 2013
